

Turn off *User Access Control* (UAC) in Windows<sup>®</sup> Vista as follows:

Important: If DL-Windows is installed, uninstall DL-Windows first, then reinstall after UAC is turned off.

1. Open the Windows<sup>®</sup> **Control Panel**.
