



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE 1401 I/C CAM STAKING FIXTURE

The Falcon 1401 I/C cam staking fixture is designed for attaching and removing cams.





* Parts of Cam Kit No. 1397

ATTACHING CAMS

- 1. Insert (2) drive pins into post holes marked "on".
- 2. Place drive washer over pins with undercut facing up.
- 3. Slide I/C housing over post engaging drive washer.
- 4. Place cam over pins with countersinks and cam number facing up.
- Using the Falcon punch, place punch point in the center of drive pin and hit with hammer. Pin must flare into countersink to be secure.


REMOVING CAMS

- 1. Slide IC housing over post marked "off".
- Using a flat tip punch (not supplied), tap drive pins through cam and drive washer.

DO NOT REUSE DRIVE PINS.
